Huak combine elements of DC post-punk, 80s Homestead-style earnestness and 90s math — a cacophonous and loose sounding but highly structured noise. Huak are evidence that punk is and will probably always be viable, evolving and relevant, as long as it is made by musicians with honest convictions and love of the music.

Secret Trees was recorded in the fall of 2008 at New Systems in Portland, Maine — a former industrial laundry facility. The track “Secret Trees” was constructed from a 20 minute improvised session centered around an Electro-Harmonix DRM32 drum machine.
